- 6 MR. GEISLER: Roll call for the regular
- 7 meeting held on October 17, 2016.
- 8 MR. PUZIO: Here.
- 9 MS. RIBAUDO: Here.
- MS. SUSINO: Here.
- MR. QUILES: Here.
- MS. BARCKETT: Here.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: Here.
- 14 CHAIRMAN DABAL: Here.
- 15 (All rise for the recitation of the Pledge of
- 16 Allegiance.)
- 17 MR. GEISLER: Approval of the minutes from
- 18 the transcript of the caucus and regular meeting held
- on September 19, 2016. Do we have a motion?
- 20 CHAIRMAN DABAL: Make the motion.
- MS. RIBAUDO: I'll second.
- MR. PUZIO: Yes.
- MS. RIBAUDO: Yes.
- MS. SUSINO: Yes.
- MR. QUILES: Yes.

- 1 MS. BARCKETT: Excused or be sustained. I
- 2 wasn't here.
- 3 MR. GIACOMARRO: Yes.
- 4 CHAIRMAN DABAL: Yes.
- 5 MS. DAY: Mr. DeMarco, if I want to make a
- 6 comment that was recorded in here last month, can I do
- 7 it now or --
- 8 MR. DE MARCO: At the public portion.
- 9 MR. GEISLER: Bills for payment. Bills
- 10 presented for payment October 17, 2016, for a total
- amount of \$92,983.59. Do we have a motion?
- 12 MR. QUILES: I'll make the motion.
- MS. RIBAUDO: I'll second.
- 14 MR. PUZIO: I abstain on check number 17061.
- 15 17061. Aye on the rest.
- MS. RIBAUDO: Yes.
- MS. SUSINO: Yes.
- MR. QUILES: Yes.
- MS. BARCKETT: Yes.
- 20 MR. GIACOMARRO: I abstain. I have not been
- 21 able to reach Mr. Katchen yet. I will.
- 22 CHAIRMAN DABAL: Commissioner Dabal abstains
- on check number 17096 and check number 3026. Yes on
- 24 the rest.
- MR. GEISLER: Okay. Do we have any -- that's

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1 it.
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- Do we have any Commissioner comment?
- 3 Any public comment?
- 4 MS. DAY: Yes. I have a comment. I would
- 5 like to address the bills that Mr. Giacomarro keeps
- 6 saying he wants -- he gets an explanation of the bills,
- 7 that he knows every bill in the board of ed. Well, I
- 8 did my own research, because he hasn't brought it in.
- 9 And I can't believe they would have an explanation next
- 10 to every bill.
- 11 What he's looking at is the description of
- 12 the line accounts. In accounting, I don't know if
- anybody has books, you have accounting line items and
- 14 line item descriptions. He's getting a line item
- 15 description. That's a very general, broad description
- of what bills are put in there. So in any one line
- item, you can have 20 different vendors with very
- 18 different things that -- services that they provided or
- 19 things that you bought from these companies can be in
- 20 the same line item. It gives you no definition of what
- 21 it is.
- He wrote in the -- well, he spoke it in the
- 23 meeting. He said, "I can't imagine giving away 170,000
- 24 not knowing what the hell I'm giving it away for."
- MR. GIACOMARRO: That's right.

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- 1 MS. DAY: Well, the board of ed was over
- 2 \$3 million.
- 3 MR. GIACOMARRO: And every item had an
- 4 explanation of what it was.
- 5 MS. DAY: No, there wasn't.
- 6 MR. GIACOMARRO: Do you have a copy of it
- 7 there?
- 8 MS. DAY: Yes, I have the copies of it. It's
- 9 a line item description. It's not -- here.
- 10 MS. BARCKETT: It's not detailed.
- 11 MS. DAY: It's not detailed.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: Of course, it can't be
- 13 detailed. I mean, you have a line. You don't have a
- 14 page.
- MS. DAY: Well, listen, this is it. Purchase
- 16 technical services. That was the description. I'll
- 17 give you the vendors that were there. Go Pro Waste.
- 18 Alliance Commercial Pest Control. Atlantic Coast
- 19 Fibers for 1950. Old Colony Group, \$4100. This is
- 20 under purchase technical services.
- 21 What is it? What did they buy? What did
- they get for that money?
- MR. GIACOMARRO: I don't recall.
- MS. DAY: I know you don't, because it's not
- 25 for you -- that line item is a description of the

- 1 accounting codes. It's not a description of the
- 2 invoice.
- MS. BARCKETT: Okay. My question to you
- 4 would be, well, can't he do that then, put what the
- 5 line item is?
- MS. DAY: Yes, we have line item codes.
- 7 Everybody has accounting --
- 8 MS. BARCKETT: When we get the bill list.
- 9 MS. DAY: We couldn't get it on there with a
- 10 check -- no, not with a check number. The only way we
- 11 can pull it up is through our cash disbursements, but
- 12 it only shows you the numbers. You would have to have
- our list, and then you would have to check --
- 14 MS. BARCKETT: I'm not doing that.
- MS. DAY: -- the chart of accounts. Listen,
- 16 3 million -- three and a half million dollars is our
- 17 yearly expenditures.
- MS. BARCKETT: Yes.
- MS. DAY: This is one month.
- MS. BARCKETT: In all fairness, I know what
- 21 Richie means, because when I look at it too --
- 22 MS. DAY: Marie, when you got a question, you
- 23 look up that one bill.
- MS. BARCKETT: Yes, right. Well, sometimes I
- 25 do look at the bills. I don't know if they're all

- 1 there, though.
- MS. DAY: They're all there. You just need
- 3 to look at the one -- listen, there is -- as I was
- 4 going through the board of ed list, there is half a
- 5 dozen of them that we use; Go Pro Waste Services,
- 6 Budget Blinds, Modern Printing, Budget Signs, W.B.
- 7 Mason, Ace Lock, Madison Plumbing Supply, Staples,
- 8 Spectrotel, PSE&G, Delta Dental. They're the same
- 9 vendors we have here. You know them over there, but
- 10 when you come here you don't know them.
- 11 MR. GIACOMARRO: I didn't say I didn't know
- 12 the vendor. I don't know what they did.
- MS. DAY: You said you didn't know not a one
- 14 last month. You -- it's right in the minutes. I --
- 15 you didn't know any of them. Is that not correct?
- MR. GIACOMARRO: Isn't that stupid? I didn't
- 17 know any of them? I didn't know Public Service --
- MS. DAY: Mr. Giacomarro, every one of them.
- 19 MR. GIACOMARRO: What does it say?
- 20 MS. DAY: You didn't know -- you wanted to
- 21 know about every one of them. Read your minutes.
- 22 MR. GIACOMARRO: I wanted to know what they
- were for.
- MS. DAY: Don't talk like that.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: Don't talk like what?

- 1 MS. DAY: Like you're talking to an imbecile
- 2 that you have to talk like that. You did that
- 3 yesterday. And you had no business being in there.
- 4 Now let's stop it right there.
- 5 MR. GIACOMARRO: No, we won't stop it right
- 6 there.
- 7 MS. DAY: Oh, yes, we will.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: Am I entitled -- am I
- 9 allowed to go in the office?
- MS. DAY: Not if nobody's in there.
- 11 MR. GEISLER: Listen, I'm not taking affront
- 12 to it, Rich, but when nobody's in the office and you
- 13 come in and you're walking around --
- 14 MR. GIACOMARRO: No, no. I had a meeting
- 15 with you in your office.
- MR. GEISLER: Yes, but I wasn't there.
- MS. DAY: I asked him to have a seat.
- 18 MR. GEISLER: Listen to me. You're a
- 19 commissioner --
- MS. DAY: I asked him to have a seat, and he
- 21 said, where's the lights? I said, excuse me?
- 22 MR. GIACOMARRO: No, no. In the waiting
- 23 room.
- MS. DAY: I told you have a seat.
- MR. GEISLER: Whatever you want to do.

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1 That's your business, but I --
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- MS. DAY: And he turned around and he said
- 3 where are the lights?
- 4 MR. GIACOMARRO: What was that?
- 5 MS. DAY: Never mind. You know what you
- 6 said.
- 7 MR. GIACOMARRO: No, I didn't.
- 8 MS. DAY: All I'm saying is, you don't know
- 9 what you're doing in the board of ed no more than you
- 10 know what you're doing here.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: No, no, you're the genius.
- 12 MS. DAY: Yeah. I just want that for the
- 13 record, because you don't know if it went to his house
- 14 neither.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: What was that? Are you
- 16 talking to me?
