- 22 things.
- MR. GIACOMARRO: The refusals, all zero.
- Does that mean they've never refused, never been asked?
- 25 MR. GEISLER: I don't know. Could be. Let

- 1 me see. Normally that's what it is.
- Listen to me, there's a lot of times we call
- 3 up -- I'll give you a for instance. I had a friend --
- 4 Mr. Puzio had a guy interested. Somebody called. I
- 5 gave him five different things, right? No --
- 6 MR. PUZIO: Forget about him.
- 7 MR. GEISLER: So he could be here for a
- 8 hundred years. You know what I mean?
- 9 MR. GIACOMARRO: That's crazy.
- 10 MR. PUZIO: If it's who I'm thinking of.
- 11 MR. GIACOMARRO: You know at the end where it
- 12 says refusal zero.
- MR. GEISLER: Hey, Col, let me ask you
- 14 something. A lot of times these people are on here so
- 15 long because we offer them things --
- MS. DAY: And they refuse it.
