- 18 strong and not diseased and it can fall down. So let's
- do something before it does fall down and somebody gets
- 20 hurt or our buildings go. And I don't want that to
- 21 happen. I'm living here a lot of years. In the
- 22 Housing.
- MR. DABAL: We have to determine if it's
- 24 healthy or not.
- 25 CHAIRMAN QUILES: There you go. That's what

- 1 I was going to say.
- 2 If you don't mind, I'll address it with
- 3 Marty. I'll talk to Marty and have him it get checked

- 5 name for it.

- 10 good.
- 11 CHAIRMAN QUILES: I think, in all fairness,
- 12 that can be done. I don't see that being a major
- 13 issue.
- 14 MS. NADA: I will leave this here.
- 15 CHAIRMAN QUILES: I'll talk to Mr. Geisler
- 16 about it.

- 18 I'm living in the Housing a lot of years, and I see a
