8	MR. GEISLER: What I wanted to say also was,
9	and I totally forgot, this is almost like an oxymoron,
10	but September 11th I drove past the building, and I'm
11	going to tell you something, our memorial looks
12	beautiful. Especially on that day with the flags.
13	Absolutely beautiful. Absolutely beautiful.
14	All right. Let's do the roll call for the
15	regular meeting.
16	MR. DABAL: Here.
17	MS. RIBAUDO: Here.
18	MR. GIACOMARRO: Here.
19	MS. BARCKETT: Here.
20	MR. PUZIO: Here.
21	CHAIRMAN QUILES: Here.
22	MS. RIBAUDO: Marty, go find Margaret so she
23	can finish that for us, please.
24	MR. DE MARCO: The pressure is on.
25	Do we have a motion to approve the minutes of

the transcript of the caucus and the regular meeting 1 2 held on August 20th, 2018? MR. DABAL: Make the motion. 3 MS. RIBAUDO: I'll second it. 4 5 MR. DABAL: Yes. 6 MS. RIBAUDO: Yes. 7 MR. GIACOMARRO: Yes. 8 MR. PUZIO: Yes. 9 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Yes. 10 MS. BARCKETT: Me. 11 MR. DE MARCO: I'm sorry. 12 MS. BARCKETT: Yes. No, I'm not here. Am I invisible? It's because I came late. 13 MR. DE MARCO: Bills presented for payment 14 15 September 17 of 2018. The operating account, expenses 16 in the amount of \$98,184.38. The capital fund, 501-17 expenses, in the amount of \$10,973.62. For a total 17 18 amount of 109,158. 19 Do I have a motion? 20 MS. RIBAUDO: I'll make the motion. 21 MR. PUZIO: I'll second it. 22 MR. DABAL: Abstain on check number 1072. 23 Yes on the rest. 24 MS. RIBAUDO: Yes. 25 MR. GIACOMARRO: Yes.

1 MS. BARCKETT: Yes. 2 MR. PUZIO: I abstain on check number 18987. 3 Aye on the rest. CHAIRMAN QUILES: Yes. 4 MR. DE MARCO: Communications, there are 5 none. Unfinished business. 6 7 New business. We have resolution number 8 2018-31. A resolution to approve the updated personnel policy, risk management and loss control plan. 9 10 Chairman Quiles, I know you have a question 11 on this. 12 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Yes. My question was to, in this case, the counsellor, was that it's not 13 14 specific enough. So they're giving up -- it is my understanding that they're giving up two half days, 15 16 correct me if I'm wrong, and they're getting one full 17 day in return. 18 MS. RIBAUDO: They're giving up Lincoln's birthday for a full day off Christmas Eve and New 19 20 Year's Eve. 21 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Correct. But that's not 22 the way it's stated here. Actually, nothing is stated 23 here. Except the way it's written. That's where I would prefer to see that in writing or as an amendment 24 to this. Can we do that? 25

1 MR. DE MARCO: Yes. 2 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Mr. Geisler, we just have a 3 little concern regarding this resolution. And I believe Mr. DeMarco will enlighten you. 4 MR. DE MARCO: So on the resolution, with 5 6 respect to the updated personnel policy, it was the 7 understanding of the Commissioners that the amendments 8 to the policy are to reflect that the employees are giving up their half day on Lincoln's birthday in 9

10 exchange for being off half day Christmas Eve. To the 11 extent that that is the revision, they want it 12 specified in the resolution that that's the manner in 13 which the policy is being amended.

MR. GEISLER: This is being amended because of risk management. As well as. But this part here is for risk management. This has nothing to do with this. This is what they want to do so we can -- for insurance purposes. We didn't come up with this on our own.

MR. DE MARCO: No. But I think what Commissioner Quiles's concern was that what's amended wasn't attached. He doesn't know what he's voting on. And that somebody brought up the holidays --MR. GEISLER: No. This is about --MS. RIBAUDO: Isn't that for the

25 personnel meeting, Mart?

1 MR. GEISLER: This is about it's been updated 2 for civil rights, family leave. That's what this is 3 about. They update --CHAIRMAN QUILES: So regarding what we were 4 just talking about, this has absolutely nothing to do 5 6 with that? 7 MR. GEISLER: This has nothing to do with that one. We have to amend --8 9 CHAIRMAN QUILES: I was under the impression 10 that was going to be part of this meeting. MR. GEISLER: Well, we'd have to do another 11 12 resolution on top of this. 13 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Okay. So you want to table that for next month and put it on for next month? 14 15 MR. GEISLER: It's not going to hurt 16 anything --17 CHAIRMAN QUILES: All right. 18 MR. GEISLER: You get your two seconds, and 19 there's a whole big thing. 20 MR. DE MARCO: I was almost done with the 21 meeting. 22 MR. GEISLER: A big production. 23 MS. RIBAUDO: You did very good. You did well. 24 25 MR. GEISLER: On Resolution 2018-31. This

1 resolution is by our risk management company, the JIF. 2 So we're compliant with our personnel policy. In case 3 there's ever any type of litigation or people need to know what they're supposed to do at different times if 4 there's some sort of problem. All right. 5 6 On Resolution 2018-31, Updated Personnel 7 Policy, Risk Management and Loss Control Plan. 8 MR. DABAL: Yes. 9 MS. RIBAUDO: Yes. 10 MR. GIACOMARRO: Yes. 11 MS. BARCKETT: Yes. 12 MR. PUZIO: Yes. CHAIRMAN QUILES: Yes. 13 MR. GEISLER: Back to our new business here. 14 15 Resolution 2018-32. "Be it resolved by the 16 Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of 17 Garfield, upon the recommendation of Martin Geisler, 18 Executive Director to the Board of Commissioners, that Tanner Bowen be hired as a full-time maintenance worker 19 20 at a salary of \$35,000 per year plus all benefits. 21 Approved at the Commissioners meeting held on 22 September 17, 2018." 23 Do we have a motion? MR. GIACOMARRO: I'll make a motion. 24 MS. RIBAUDO: I'll second it. 25

1 MR. GEISLER: You can sign it. You can all 2 sign it when we hire somebody. It's nice. 3 MR. DABAL: Yes. MS. RIBAUDO: Yes. 4 5 MR. GIACOMARRO: Yes. 6 MS. BARCKETT: Yes. MR. PUZIO: Yes. 7 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Yes. 8 MR. GEISLER: Do we have a motion to close? 9 10 MR. DE MARCO: Any Commissioner comments? 11 MR. GEISLER: Any Commissioner comments? Any 12 public comment? 13 MR. PUZIO: I make the motion to close. MR. GEISLER: I again want to congratulate 14 15 Mr. Puzio. We're going to have you a couple more 16 years. 17 MR. PUZIO: Thank you. MS. BARCKETT: Second. 18 19 MR. DABAL: Yes. 20 MS. RIBAUDO: Yes. 21 MR. GIACOMARRO: Yes. 22 MS. BARCKETT: Yes. 23 MR. PUZIO: Yes. 24 CHAIRMAN QUILES: Yes. 25 MR. DE MARCO: 6:30.
